Sir John Reid Community Service Award

Rotary Melbourne wishes to pay tribute to those dedicated achievers, and encourage others to follow their lead through the Sir John Reid Community Service Award.

This award is a permanent memorial to Sir John Reid, who served Rotary Melbourne for over 45 years, being its President in 1953-54. Since its inception in 1987, the Award has been given each year to honour an individual in the Victorian community whose volunteer service is judged to be worthy of special notice.

The generosity of the John T Reid Charitable Trusts has made it possible for Rotary Melbourne to make a significant grant of up to \$10,000 to the organisation where the awardee has volunteered.

To be considered for the award, nominees must:

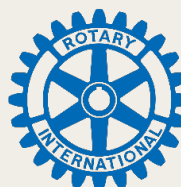
- Have made an outstanding contribution to the local community in Victoria.
